

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Neither OBH (Hughenden) Branch of The Pony Club, the Organisers and the Land Owners nor any person acting on their behalf, accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators, or any other persons or property whatsoever.
2. The Organiser of this event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health, safety and welfare of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organiser and all the Officials and Stewards.
3. All competitors must be suitably dressed in correct riding attire. PC members' hats must be tagged. Hats approved to PAS 015:1998, EN1384:1996, BS EN 1384:1997 with BSI Kitemark, Snell E2001 with official Snell label and number, AS/NZS 3838:1998 or the AS/NZS 3838:2003 standards must be worn. Hats must be correctly fastened at all times when mounted. Only blunt spurs without rowels or sharp edges may be worn (Pony Club members must have their DC's written permission or their B test). If the spur is curved the curve must be downwards. For dress and tack rules please visit the Pony Club website www.pcuk.org under dressage.
4. The event will be run under Pony Club Show Dressage Rules 2012 amended where applicable, and British Dressage Rules 2012. Tests can be commanded.
5. The Judges' decision is final in all events.
6. No horses or ponies under 4 years of age are to be ridden on the showground.
7. The OBH (Hughenden) Branch of the Pony Club reserve the right to refuse or reject any entry or cancel a class at their discretion.
8. No entry fee will be refunded unless a class is cancelled or a Doctor's or Veterinary Surgeon's Certificate is produced and dated no later than 13th April 2012.
9. In the event of cancellation by the organiser a £2 administration charge will be retained.
10. Any complaints must be in writing and handed to the Show Secretary within 15 minutes of the incident, together with a fee of £20.00, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
11. Riders are requested to ride sensibly at all times and to respect the land upon which they are riding. Anyone galloping a horse on the showground may be asked to leave.

All entrants and spectators are kindly asked not to leave any litter. Horseboxes and trailers must not be mucked out on to the ground. Please clean up any dung or hay left near your horsebox or trailer. Please also refrain from allowing your horses on any of the grass areas whether ridden or led. These are all at the request of the landowners. Many thanks.
