## CHATEAU DE BRION

**Origin:** The sire, Cassini I was successful under Franke Sloothaak for some years, with whom he won many Grand Prix, Nations Cups and World Cups. Cassini I is surely by far the most sought-after breeding sons of Capitol I. In 2006, his licensed sons Eurocommerce Berlin (breeding name: Casper)/Gerco Schröder/NED and Cavalor Cumano/Jos Lansink/BEL became Team and Individual Jumping World Champion respectively. He has produced a total of 20 license sons and numerous State Premium Mares, who are securing the survival of his genes. Many of Cassini's progeny have presented themselves extremely well at the Bundeschampionat contests and various auctions sites. The dam, Accola, was highly successful in tests for young riding horses, aptitude tests and j level dressage tests. She also gave birth to Cristobal K (by Coriander), who qualified for the Bundeschampionat in dressage, and to the mare Gaccola (by Lordj who later produced the licensed stallion Lord Donnerlord (by Donnerbube I). The dam's sire, Caribo GL, produced three licensed sons, among them the winner of the Westphalian licensing, Carnaby GL, and eleven State Premium Mares. His first crop of foals was born in 1987 and brought forth Wichita, the winner of the mare performance test in Elmshorn. Many of his daughters were among the high achievers at broodmare shows and performance tests. His offspring earned over 300,000 Euros in dressage and show jumping until 2006. The granddam, Selika, also produced a full brother to the dam, called Cacharel, who was successful in dressage up to Intermediate I, and the M level jumper Benett (by Calvados II). The great-granddam, State Premium Mare Hellas, also gave birth to the Intermediate I dressage horse Chevalier (by Calvados II), the M/A level jumper Chaco Z (by Caribo GL) and the M level eventer Pira (by Roberto). In the fourth generation, two precious thoroughbreds appear - Ladykiller xx and Rushing Water xx. The foundation sire, Cor de la Bryere, appears in the maternal as well as in the paternal bloodline, adding a valuable inbreeding component to Chateau de Brion's pedigree. Chateau de Brion descends from line 6378, which also produced the stallions Admont, Dr. Jackson D, Indigo and Wildschütz.

**Performance record:** Chateau de Brion completed the stallion performance test in Marbach in 2005, clearly proving his jumping-orientation. As a four-year old, he captured wins in tests for young jumpers at A and L level. In 2007, Ben Maher/GBR took over his further training and has already presented him at shows in Italy. Due to the fact that Chateau de Brion's successes were attained abroad, his lifetime winnings cannot be stated correctly here. In 2001 Chateau de Brion was also licensed by the Holsteiner Verband.
