

MARE CHECKLIST

DEFRA regulations have meant that we are obliged to request the following for every mare that comes to Stud. Please use this checklist to ensure that your mare is ready to travel to Stud – thank you.

PRIOR TO TRAVELLING TO STUD:

The following paperwork needs to have been sent Quainton Stud prior to sending your Mare;

- Negative CEM swab results – dated in current breeding season
- EVA blood test results – dated within 30 days of arrival at Stud
- Nomination Form – completed in full and signed, it is very important that all health and breeding history of the mare is included.
- Declaration of Health – completed and signed by your vet

In addition, please check the following:

- If appropriate, has your insurance company been advised that you are sending your mare to Stud?
- Have you had your mare's hind shoes removed?

Current DEFRA and EU regulations now state that all horses must travel with their Passports and that the declaration concerning administration of medicinal treatments is signed by the owner:
