Bellow Hill is the retained veterinary practice for this stud and unless instructed otherwise will be used for this mare. Accounts will be sent direct to the owner of the mare and must be settled promptly. For clients using the veterinary package a cheque must be left on delivery of mare.

If a mare is certified by a licensed veterinarian to not be in foal by 1st of October of this breeding year or if a live foal of five (5) days of age is not achieved by this breeding, the Mare Owner is entitled to a "No Foal Free Return Breeding". This will extend for only one (1) following breeding season after the date in this contract. A live foal is defined as one that stands and nurses, living past five (5) days old. The Mare Owner is entitled to pay Handling Fees of £50.00 for this new breeding as stated within this contract. In such case if breeding or re-breeding is necessary the Mare Owner is not entitled to any refunds of Breeding Fees or Handling Fee whatsoever.

I have read and understood the 'General Terms & Conditions 2011' (see over) and 'charging rates 2011' for mares visiting Quainton Stud for Artificial Insemination and/or Foaling. I agree to pay the account in full prior to the removal of the mare.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS 2011

1. Artificial Insemination (AI): Mares are taken at livery for insemination with fresh or chilled semen including semen that has been sent from elsewhere (UK and abroad)
2. Equine Viral Arteritis (EVA): The British Equestrian Federation's Breeders' Quality Mark (BQM) scheme and Horserace Betting Levy Board EVA Code recommends all mares for AI should be blood tested after 1 January and within 28 days before breeding activities begin. All domestic and imported mares must be tested before coming to Stud.
3. Contagious Equine Metritis (CEM) Mares must be swabbed (Clitoral) prior to arriving at stud and have with them on arrival a negative certificate
4. Equine Influenza & Tetanus: It is recommended all mares have an up to date vaccination certificate.
5. Arrival Time: The best time for mares to arrive is just before they are due to come in season and their follicular development will be constantly monitored to obtain the optimum timing for insemination.
6. Nomination Form: All owners/agents are required to fill in and sign our form when they bring the mare to stud if not sent in advance. If the mare is sent with a third party the form must be completed and signed before the mare arrives.
7. Mare Passports / Identification: It is a legal requirement that mares are accompanied to stud with their passport; we will check the identity of the mare with the passport on arrival.
8. Invoicing: On a monthly basis and to be paid within 14 days of date of invoice. The final account for all board fees, veterinary work, other costs incurred and outstanding invoices must be paid before the mares leave the Stud. Mare owners who send a third party to collect their mare must make arrangements to pay in advance of collection. Mares will not be allowed to leave before payment is made in full. Payment by cash, cheque, debit or credit card. (Credit cards charged at 5%). Interest will be charged on overdue accounts. VAT is charged on all accounts.
9. Hind Shoes: Please make sure all mares arrive at stud without hind shoes. We would be happy to arrange for this to be done at cost £15 .
10. Blacksmith: Mares and foals will have their feet trimmed when necessary and any costs charged to the owner's account. Any specific shoeing requirements must be notified to the Stud when the mare is booked in.
11. Worming: Mares and foals will be wormed on arrival at stud and then when due thereafter and the owner charged accordingly.
12. Scanning: It is Stud policy to scan all mares.
13. Veterinary: Assistance will be called in when deemed necessary by the Stud and all costs will be chargeable to the owner.
14. Insurance: The Stud accepts no responsibility for visiting horses and does not carry insurance cover; it is the owner's responsibility to provide their own insurance cover.
15. Mares and foals whilst at Quanton Stud will receive every possible care, attention and supervision, but the Stud accepts no responsibility whatsoever for accident, theft or disease, nor does the Stud give any express or implied guarantee of success.

16.All mares are inseminated at their owners risk and the Stud is not to be liable for any damages or compensation in respect of any injury or damage howsoever caused to any mare, including (but not limited to) that caused through teasing / artificial insemination.

17.Owners must accept that while their horse is at Quinton Stud it is at their risk - no responsibility for the mare can be accepted by the Stud and all liability claims, damages, costs, loss and expense of any kind whatsoever are hereby expressly excluded.

18.The Stud reserves the right to refuse entry to the stud to any mare or foal in the event that any of these conditions are not complied with or where they consider that mare or foal to be an unacceptable health risk.
